



5th Grade Supply List Palmetto Charter School

It is important that you come to school daily with the following supplies. Please bring them with you to “Meet the Teacher” in August. Please do not write on any of the items, unless noted. Some supplies will be collected for classroom use. Please bring **ONLY** the items on the list. Space is limited, therefore, large binders, pocket pencil sharpeners, pencil boxes, and large backpacks with wheels are not permitted. Please only send water bottles with a pop-up mouth piece. Yeti, Tervis, or water bottles with a screw on top are not permitted. Items brought to school that are not on this list will be sent home.

- ◆ Twistables Colored Pencils
- ◆ Fiskars Scissors
- ◆ 3 Packs of Pencil Cap Erasers
- ◆ SOFT Zipper Pencil Pouch
- ◆ Headphones/Earbuds — unpackaged and in a Ziploc with name
- ◆ Travel umbrella — with name to be stored in backpack
- ◆ 2 Glue Sticks or Glue Pens
- ◆ 4 Highlighters in different colors
- ◆ Sharpened Pencils (Extra Lead if Mechanical)
- ◆ 2 Packages wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- ◆ 1 RED, 1 GREEN, 1 BLUE, 1 PURPLE, — 2 pocket PLASTIC portfolio folder with 3-prongs— each filled with wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- ◆ 1 Composition Notebooks (Not spiral bound)— may be any color/design
- ◆ Snack Size Ziploc Bags (Last name begins with A-H)
- ◆ Quart Size Ziploc Bags (Last name begins with I-P)
- ◆ Gallon Size Ziploc Bags (Last name begins with Q-Z)
- ◆ Clorox/Lysol wipes (store brand is ok, too!)
- ◆ SPILL-PROOF, INSULATED Water Bottle with POP-UP MOUTH PIECE (No Yeti, Tervis, etc.)
